## Virtual Class Contract

### For the Parent

Please read the following instructions for virtual classes.

1. Links to the week's class will be sent by email on Sunday. If you have not received them by Sunday night please contact us.
2. Students should be on time. The staff reserve the right to "lock" virtual events after they have begun to prevent unapproved entry.
3. For younger students, please be available to help them get settled into their class at the beginning.
4. We require that students show their face at least once to confirm identity. They are not technically required to keep their camera on but it will certainly help with participation.

### For the Parents and Students

Attending Virtual Classes is a big responsibility. In order for everyone to have fun and learn safely we all need to follow certain rules. A lot of these rules are very similar to being in a regular classroom and they need to be remembered for virtual classes.

1. Always be dressed as if you were in a real classroom.
2. If your camera is on, use your face and body to show that you are paying attention and not distracting to the other kids.
3. You may be "muted" for some of the class so that the teacher can talk without being interrupted. The teacher will instruct you on how to get their attention - usually a thumbs up. If the group is not muted, use your words appropriately to not talk over other students or be distracting.
4. Always use appropriate language.
